It's actually a system of planets, not unlike how we like to call our own solar system. The name "Epsilon Eridani" stands for the parent star, or their "sun," and it has two probable planets orbiting it: one confirmed (Epsilon Eridani b) another yet unconfirmed (Epsilon Eridani c), making it the closest planetary system at just over 10 light years from the solar system.

Beside Earth, five other planets were known to the ancients—Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, and Saturn—and two were discovered after the invention of the telescope: Uranus and Neptune. Each planet stays in its own "traffic lane," following a nearly circular orbit about the Sun and obeying the "traffic ...

Traveling out beyond Mars to our sun's outer planets, we would find conditions no more hospitable.
